The Assistant Manager of Youth Engagement position is a full-time, 40 hours per week, position. The Assistant Manager of Youth Engagement is responsible for providing direct educational and mentoring services to the Center's youth audience participating in the Community and Urban Science Enrichment (CAUSE) Youth Development Program (grades 8-12) by designing, developing material and implementing "whole child" programs/training which enhance the youths' learning experiences and promote their developmental success. In addition, the AMYE recruits and oversees all middle school programming aspects.

A successful candidate will be an engaging educator, with solid experience in researching, developing and facilitating fun and engaging activities focused on environmental and outdoor education, positive youth development, and community education. The program primarily runs during after school hours and most Saturdays during the school year and Monday-Friday during the summer
